Wellness Safety Meeting

September 26, 2024

- 1. Discussion of Wellness policy
- Safety Routines:
 - a. Larger numbers to identify buildings for emergency personnel/deliveries.
 - b. The app on all faculty member phones to use during an actual emergency makes parents feel a sense of safety.
 - c. Bullying students stated they have not noticed bullying on campus. Parents and employees stated they did not see bullying and none had been reported. Verden Schools does have a bullying policy in their handbooks and board policy.
 - d. Teachers discussed the new door added to the gym for quicker safer access for the elementary school.
- 3. Human trafficking:
- a. Resource booklet at each sight that has information to help identify and resources to help teachers/administrators with human trafficking.
- b. A sex offender app was mentioned to identify local offenders. Officer Moore said he would get information on this to each office.
- 4. Suicide- If anything pertaining to suicide is reported at school parents are immediately notified. We remain in constant contact with the student and keep continuous supervision until parents or emergency personnel arrive. Follow up is then done with our school counselor.
- 5. Students with special needs- With new students each year discussion on the importance of all staff aware of each student's need on a 504. Our special education director notifies coaches, teachers and all need to know personal information of any and all special needs that are to be paid attention to each year
- 6. Playground safety- With our growing enrollment discussion about proper use of equipment and continued monitoring on the playground is a must. The new wood chips help with accidents and are appreciated by parents.
- 7. Avoiding dehydration during physical activity. Students can use water fountains or bring their own water bottles at any time.
- 8. New Business:
 - a. It was discussed that we should look into having supplies in the office to make a splint for injuries
 - b. During cafeteria time faculty can not remove items from the salad bar and pass out to students. Students must go through the line at the salad bar 1 time.
 - c. During dismissal making sure drivers are following all safety signs(yield sign) and going the speed limit It was suggested that we add another yield sign going into the campus.
 - d. Parents at high school coming into parking spots too fast.
 - e. Social Media challenges discussion about staying aware
